World Day for Safety and Health at Work



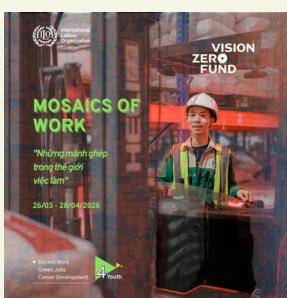
Following the ILO theme for [SafeDay 2026](#), “Let’s ensure a healthy psychosocial working environment,” Vision Zero Fund (VZF) projects organized activities to support constituents’ actions to promote safer and healthier working environments. Below is a compilation of these initiatives.



VZF Colombia launched the booklet [Smart Promotion and Care for Mental Health](#) (in Spanish), which provides companies with practical tools to prevent psychosocial risks through an early warning system enabling timely data analysis, risk assessment, and effective preventive and control measures to safeguard mental health in the workplace.



Joining the ILO Brazil campaign “*Quality coffee has aroma, flavour, and decent work*,” **VZF Brazil** developed [promotional materials on psychosocial risks in rural work](#) for producers, workers, and other actors (in Portuguese). A [webinar](#) on challenges and good practices in managing these risks—featuring speakers from government and workers’ organizations—was also organized.



VZF Vietnam marked the day with a youth-focused campaign on psychosocial factors at work, featuring the “Mosaics of Work” photo contest and a panel discussion on psychosocial working environments. Bringing together youth, academia, ILO constituents, and OSH practitioners, the initiative used visual storytelling to highlight mental well-being and other often overlooked workplace issues, while promoting dialogue on safer and healthier workplaces.
